Cost

Camp RAVE is \$50 every week. Payments are due by Monday of each week. ***If payments are not received by the end of day Tuesday, the child will not be permitted to finish that week or attend camp until payment is received.***

Cost includes: light breakfast, lunch, snack, games, crafts, weekly activities, and most field trips!

How to Register

To register for camp, return this form with **\$10 non refundable application** fee by **May 14** to the Chances And Services for Youth (1101 S. 13th Street Terre Haute, IN 47802). Camp RAVE accepts registration forms on a first-come, first-serve basis. First 60 campers per week will be accepted. Parent/Guardian will be notified by **May 18** about acceptance into camp.

Note: *If your child is registered for a week and does not attend, you are responsible for payment for that week.*
