



RATES EFFECTIVE FROM JULY 1, 2022 TO JUNE 30, 2023*

*Regarding these rates, Child and Adult Care Food Program institutions face continued challenges related to the COVID-19 pandemic. To help alleviate some of those challenges, the Keep Kids Fed Act of 2022 provides temporary additional funding in the amount of .10 for each meal and supplement served. This temporary additional reimbursement amount will be available beginning July 1, 2022 and ending on June 30, 2023. Also with the Keep Kids Fed Act of 2022 Tier 2 CACFP providers will continue to receive Tier 1 rates from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

Tiering status is determined by school, census, and/or provider's income.

In order for providers own children's meals to be claimed and reimbursed the provider must qualify by income. CASY food program staff will determine eligibility.

Only one meal per child may be claimed at each meal service. Up to three meals, one of which must be a supplement/snack, may be claimed for each enrolled child per day.
